
Classical Music Masterclass

Short bio

Luka Faulisi started to play the violin at the age of three and he was a student of Boris Belkin at the Conservatorium Maastricht in the Netherlands. Currently, he is a student of Professor Pavel Berman at the Academy Lorenzo Perosi in Biella, Italy. Over the years, through personal mentoring, several distinguished artists have influenced Luka's musical formation. Pavel Berman describes him as an 'incredibly gifted virtuoso violinist'. Recent debuts include performances with the Orchestre National du Capitole de Toulouse with Wilson Ng at the Halle aux Grains; Menuhin Academy Camerata Soloists at the KKL Luzern Konzertsaal; Serbia Symphony Orchestra in Belgrade; Szczecin Philharmonic under the baton of Case Scaglione. Luka's debut album "Aria" has been released by Sony Classical International on March 3, 2023.

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Igor Correti Kuret

Short bio

Igor Correti Kuret is an Internationally esteemed violinist and conductor, Maestro Igor Coretti-Kuret is particularly appreciated for his ability to teach music and communicate with young musicians. He is the founder, Chief Conductor, and Artistic Director of ESYO, the European Spirit of Youth Orchestra. He was a guest conductor of the "Moldova" Philharmonic Orchestra in Iași (Romania). He was granted the CEI Medal of Honour for his commitment and his results with the CEI Youth Orchestra. In the summer of 1989, while the Berlin wall was still standing, M^o Coretti-Kuret organized his first music school for young musicians from different European countries, who later formed what was known as CEI Youth Orchestra and eventually evolved into ESYO.

Peter Stark's performances as a conductor are exhilarating, imaginative, and inspiring. At the heart of all his work lies a passion and commitment to the study and practice of music to profit humanity. Peter is the Rehearsal Director of the European Union Youth Orchestra and a Professor of Conducting at London's Royal College of Music. His reputation as a teacher and mentor is internationally renowned. Peter's growing media profile includes his appointment as a series consultant to the popular BBC television series 'Maestro' and regular screen appearances as a mentor. Whilst having performed with a number of the world's leading ensembles such as the London Symphony Orchestra, the Hallé, the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, the English Chamber Orchestra, the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment, and the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra Peter fosters a hunger to work with any orchestra that plays with spirit and enthusiasm. He is the Principal Conductor of the Arabian Youth Orchestra and Principal Guest Conductor of the Singapore National Youth Orchestra. Between 1985 and 2010 Peter was Conductor in Residence of the National Youth Orchestra of Great Britain.
