Starting the year with a Groove, the first Orchestral Course of 2024 will represent a dive into the exciting blend of an orchestra/big band crossover ensemble and an opportunity to learn and tackle the notorious rhythmic challenges of "the Swing". The Orchestral Course's finale will be a concert performance in Skopje and besides its week-long immersive preparation process, it will include in-depth lectures led by Timothy Redmond focusing on chamber music, additional side concerts and fun extracurriculars.

MENTOR / SOLOIST: Harry Apps is a professional actor and singer. Recently appearing on the international stage, he played Marius in Les *Miserables* in the 2019's UK and Ireland tour, and again at Sondheim Theatre in 2020.





Classical Music Orchestral Course

For Winds (Woodwinds and Brass)

(12th to 20th of February 2024)

The FAME'S Wind Ensemble Course is designed to enhance skills through the Wind Chamber repertoire, applicable in both chamber music and orchestral settings. Additionally, applicants will be introduced to Wind Chamber music that is less frequently performed in a typical university environment. The Seminar, done in collaboration with the Liszt Academy in Budapest, will focus on enhancing the students' chamber music skills and is one of the special seminars dedicated to a specific instrument group.

Film Music & Recording OrchestralCourse

For Strings + Winds + Percussions

(4th to 14th of April 2024)

The Film Music & Recording Orchestral Course will be led by prominent film music composer Alastair King. This program will include composers chosen through an open call and will be an immersion into the process of creation and production of film music. The course will also include a three-day recording workshop led by Margarita Kalcheva and Joaquim Badia where the students will have the opportunity to work on improving their individual as well as orchestra recording skills, learn about the technical aspects of music recording and production and gain valuable insight in the editing and mixing process alongside FAME'S' studio team. This additional workshop will focus on promoting gender equality in music and will include recording a piece by a young female composer. (TBA)

He regularly collaborates with some of today's most prominent media composers. Also, he frequently conducts the Chamber Orchestra of London and has led various other orchestras and choirs such as the London Symphony Orchestra BBC Concert Orchestra Northern Sinfonia London Session Orchestra Metro Voices BBC Philharmonic the Bach Choir the Choir of the King's Consort BBC National Orchestra and Chorus of Wales and the Vienna ORTF Orchestra.





Recording Orchestral Course

For Strings + Winds + Percussions

(11th to 18th of May 2024)

The Course, done in collaboration with the Conservatoire of Amsterdam will give performing musicians real life experience of collaborating with media composers on bringing original music written for film to life, working in a professional recording studio and understanding the requirements of producing professional level performances under a tight deadline. 5 young composers will record their Film music soundtracks for animations movies produced by Netherlands Film academies, with our students led by our professional technical team and

The Course will provide comprehensive training for musicians of the recording process. This masterclass will emphasize the importance of in-depth knowledge in music theory and techniques. Through a series of engaging activities participating musicians will gain real-life experience in collaborating with media composers.

For Strings + Winds + Percussions

(19th to 24th of May 2024)

The Orchestral Course will be led by Diane Louie, leader of the Hip Hop Orchestra for The Harmony Project, an award-winning research-based program that targets at-risk youth in underserved areas of Los Angeles, a program that has been recognized by the President's Committee on the Arts and Humanities as one of the best youth and humanities programs in the nation. This unique Orchestral Course will provide insight into the world of music production for Media, will help prepare students to create and maintain a workflow with trade-typical production elements such as rundown and production schedule and will introduce students to a variety of music industry careers including Music Director, House Band Leader, and Dance Arranger. Students will be able to improve their ability to accompany musical artists., coordinate timed music performances, and communicate effectively in high-stress environments.

As an ensemble inspired by the sound of Arvo Pärt and Aphex Twin, this Orchestral Course will be a rare opportunity for students to work on an innovative repertoire and expand their artistic horizons under the direction of Maestro Van Alphen.

The quartet meanders through musical traditions sometimes on the intersection of classical and jazz while always soulful and with blues and sways across the stage according to an improvised choreography.

The second Orchestral Course as part of Seminar #6 will focus specifically on strings and will be led by **Maestro Vesko Eschkenazy**. As well as leading the program, he will also be performing as a soloist and the Program will include the beautiful Tchaikovsky's *Serenade for Strings*. The entire Course will be dedicated to all aspects of playing a string instrument, exploring its versatility and different approaches in solo performance, chamber music performance, and orchestral work.

MENTOR / CONDUCTOR: Vesko Eschkenazy has been concertmaster of the Concertgebouw Orchestra since January 2000 having occupied the same position earlier with the Netherlands Chamber Orchestra and the Netherlands Philharmonic Orchestra. Among his prizes are those of the Wieniawski Competition in Poland (1985) and the Carl Flesch Competition in London (1988). In 2010 he was voted Musician of the Year in Bulgaria. He performed as soloist with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra and the London Philharmonic Orchestra under conductors such as Yuri Bashmet, Colin Davis, Carlo Maria Giulini, Kurt Masur, Seiji Ozawa and Mstislav Rostropovich..

The last of the July Orchestral Courses for 2024 will be led by **violinist Irina Muresanu and Conductor Scott Flavin.** The Course will feature lectures from both mentors and working on a Broadway–inspired Program. Film Music Orchestral Course

For Small Symphony Orchestra

(10th - 17th of September 2024)

The Seminar #6 Film Music Orchestral Course will be a unique project in collaboration with the national Cinematheque of N. Macedonia, and under the mentorship of Maestro Mirian Khukhunaishvili. It will feature the preparation of a live Soundtrack Program for two Silent Movies that will be performed as an open-air concert at the Silent and Classical Film Festival in Skopje. Students will have the rare opportunity to perform a silent movie masterpiece: "Blackmail" by Hitchcock, whose music is composed by Neil Brand.

MENTOR / CONDUCTOR: Mirian Khukhunaishvili, co-founder and music director of the Tbilisi Youth Orchestra, is an Iceland-based Georgian conductor. Praised by Christoph Eschenbach as a "tremendously gifted young conductor" after his debut with the Konzerthausorchester Berlin, the young Maestro is on his way to conquering the hearts of European orchestras. Mirian has led orchestras such as the Tonhalle-Orchester Zürich, Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, Konzerthausorchester Berlin, Bamberger Symphoniker, Danish National Symphony Orchestra, Oslo Philharmonic Orchestra, Iceland Symphony Orchestra and many more.

The culmination of our 2024 Seminar Program will be a tribute to the 'Journey' Original Soundtrack the Grammy-winning video game soundtrack composed by Austin Wintory. This soundtrack holds a special place in history as it was the first video game soundtrack ever to be nominated for a Grammy Award, specifically nominated for Best Score Soundtrack for Visual Media. The Course will be led by Austin Wintory himself and will involve a week-long preparation for a multimedia concert performance. This event will offer students an unparalleled opportunity to delve into the dynamic and innovative field of video game music. It represents a significant milestone in recognizing the artistic value of video game soundtracks.

MENTOR / CONDUCTOR: Austin Wintory is an American composer for film and video games. He is known for scoring the video games Flow and Journey, the latter of which made history as the only video game soundtrack to be nominated for the Grammy Award for Best Score Soundtrack for Visual Media. Having built his career on curiosity and experimentation, he has written scores for numerous video games (among which Assasin's Creed), well as several Film scores and has won many awards throughout his musical carreer.





FAME'S INSTITUTE

European Creative Orchestral Program for Skilled Youth

FAME'S Project, a production company specialized in orchestral music recordings for the international film and medias industries has launched the FAME'S Institute in 2021 which offers a unique orchestral program aimed at young highly skilled European musicians. The project is co-funded by the Creative Europe Programme of the European Union.



The program is unique in the sense that it complements the traditional classical orchestra repertoire with orchestral music for film, medias, video games, electronic, cross-over and other alternative performance styles. Moreover the young musicians can acquire practical skills in recording techniques and benefit from using the up-to-date equipment and know-how at FAME'S studios under the supervision of conductors composers and other musical experts.





THE PROGRAM

The Program offers various topics for each master class, including Film/Media/Video Game music, Hybrid Jazz Cross Over, Modern music, Carte blanche Classical, Baroque, and Contemporary music.

These master classes are organized as a two-week program held five times a year (February, April, May, July, and September). It contributes to develop their ability and interpretational skills but also encourage their creativity and musical expression.

It gives them the opportunity to work with international professionals, conductors, artists and orchestral musicians. They discover new artistic horizons which encourages them to build up their networks and search for new possibilities. It is a great investment for their future professional careers.

The distinctiveness of our program is that the Seminar includes immersive recording sessions, where students have the unique chance to participate in professional projects for international composers and production companies. This hands-on experience allows them to actively engage in professional projects and gain invaluable insights into the industry. The participants have also the opportunity to record (audio and video) a solo repertoire piece that they can use as a 'visiting card' for application or audition.

APPLICATION PROCESS

APPLYING before the end of December gives the students the opportunity to choose the best period of the year that fits their availabilities, and select the Master Classes they wish to attend.
